### Textbook Policy

Textbooks are purchased through funds provided by the Public Education Department Instructional Materials budget and are the property of the State of New Mexico. Students are held accountable for damage and lost textbooks and will be assessed a fine in these situations. Failure to pay fines may result in withholding the report card or transcript. (Ed Standards of NM Schools 1989)

In compliance with SB 1019 New Mexico School for the Arts will provide core courses with enough textbooks so that students have a copy of the book to take home when necessary.

This Textbook Policy is adopted by the Governing Council of New Mexico School for the Arts, effective as of Jan. 11, 2011.
