## ...YOUR THEATER AUDITION

### What to expect:

- Please arrive 15 minutes prior to your audition time. Come into the lobby of the building and sign in. You will be given a number and have a picture taken of you. You will be directed to wait with a group of applicants that will audition with you.
- The audition will begin with an orientation for students and parents/guardians. This will be your chance to meet the panel and ask basic questions. Parents/guardians must be present for this portion. It will last for fifteen minutes.
- After the orientation, the group will audition together for 30 minutes. The group audition will include warm up exercises and some improvisational theater. Parents/guardians will be invited to wait in the lobby through the rest of the audition process.
- After the group auditions, individual auditions will begin where you will present your monologues to the panel. The panel they will give you feedback and ask you some questions in order to find out more about you personally, particularly your interest and motivation to pursue advanced theater art studies at NMSA.
- You will be free to go after your individual audition is over.
- If you are missing school in order to attend your audition, please ask for an excuse note at the sign-in table.

### What to prepare:

- Your monologues/recitations. They should each be no more than two minutes in length and vary in setting and mood.

### What to bring:

1. Completed Medical and Media Release Form
2. Since you may have to wait a little bit while other applicants do their individual auditions, please bring a small snack and some water
3. Please wear comfortable clothing that you can move around in easily
4. Patience and a positive attitude
5. Your passion for theater
